The Hagan ranch consists of three families united to present this high quality horse sale. Shawne and Jocelyn are the parents of four: Alistair, Amanda, Thomas and Bronwen. Locating themselves about 14 miles southwest of Virden, Shawne and Jocelyn have been involved in every aspect of the ranching business - from the purebred Charolais business, to the PMU industry, to the current commercial cow/calf/yearling operation. While maintaining a herd of 600 black cows, Shawne and Jocelyn are able to live the dream of a family-run operation, train horses and live the cowboy lifestyle. Shawne rides his horses with one hand and they are always ready to do any and every job. If you were to drive into Shawne and Jocelyn's yard on any given day, you would find it was abuzz with activity, with visitors dropping in from nearby Cromer all the way to Montreal.



Alistair is the oldest son and has created a ranch of his own with his wife Erin. Their biggest accomplishment to date is the birth of their daughter Harley Mae this spring. Living only two and a half miles from Shawne and Jocelyn, teamwork is essential in the operation of both ranches. Running 230 of their own Angus/Hereford cows, Alistair and Erin are looking for the perfect balance between modern marketing and cowboy tradition. Whether it is AI heifers, alley sorting, riding at the Auction Mart or round-penning colts, these two use their horses for every job on the ranch. This year Erin is trying to find a balance between being a full time horse trainer and being a new mom. Erin's barrel racing can always be traced back to basic ranch work from her seasoned barrel horses to futurity colts. Alistair and Erin feel the exposure and endurance of the "real" world make for much better, more rounded barrel horses. Alistair and Erin are committed to broadening their horizons, taking any clinics and surrounding themselves with knowledge. (Alistair working for 1994 World Champion steer wrestler Blaine Pederson, and Erin for multiple NFR qualifier Judy Myllymaki) They believe one should never quit learning.



Thomas and Felicity reside with in the town of Virden, MB. They run 20 head of cattle with Thomas's parents, and own their own string of horses. As well as training horses for a living, Thomas is a hired man on the Hagan Ranch while Felicity works part-time at ACL. Thomas competes in the MRCA and CCA Rodeo Associations in steer wrestling and tie down roping, last year winning the CCA year end high point and steer wrestling champion. While he is putting on the miles to surrounding rodeos, Felicity has invested her time and money in the real estate market in Virden - buying, fixing, and renting local homes. These two find their passion lies around the equine industry and look forward to the many changes of the future.



All Hagan horses have been moved into the ranch program first before taking on any other jobs. With this strong foundation, the prospective buyer can feel comfortable pursuing any discipline. By placing these horses in stressful, strenuous and out-of-the-ordinary situations, we are able to test them mentally and physically, preparing them for future training. 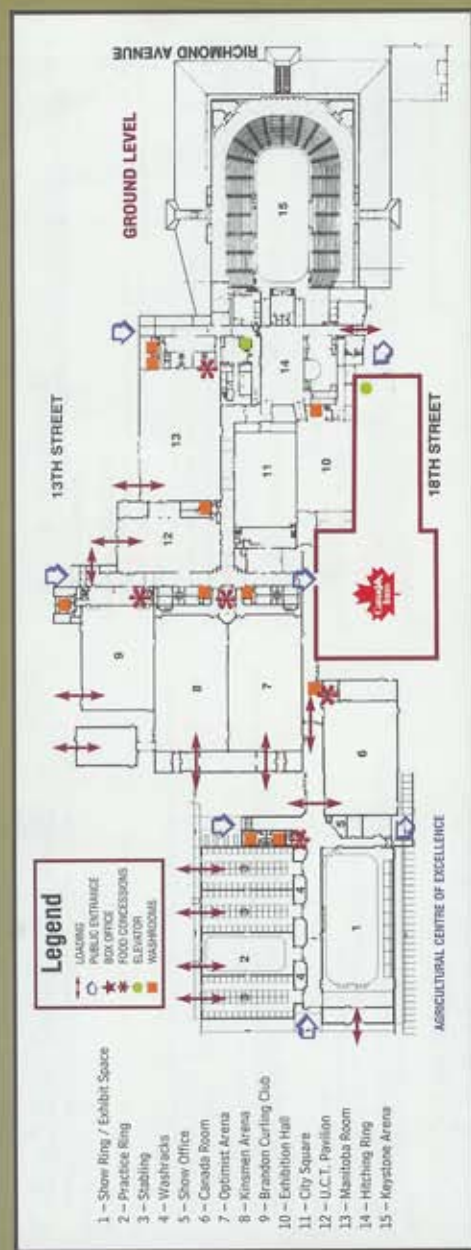

Why they are called "ranch horses"

Being a Hagan "ranch horse", means our horses are literally used in the day-to-day operation of our ranches. We start and complete every ranch job imaginable on horseback, and do things the "cowboy way". In the day and age of modern machines and conveniences, we choose to use the tried, tested and true methods of the "ranch horse". They are powered by determination, driven by sheer will and love of their job, and they always start in cold weather! Not only do we move cows 15 miles to pasture in the spring, but we use them to calve out the cows; sort off pairs; rope, tag, and drag all the calves to the fire at branding time; AI breed; rotate pastures; rope and tie off to doctor the yearlings, cows and bulls; sort the bulls from the herd mid-summer; sort off the calves at weaning time; provide doctoring services on horseback to a neighboring herd of 2500 head of yearlings; round pen and halter break colts; ride at the auction mart in the winter; and provide our non-ranch family with scenic trail rides on their visits from the city. We never go a day without riding horseback, be it for work or pleasure. So we feel confident and proud in professing that our horses truly earn the right to be called "ranch horses".
